④ Town of Clover Campground Report

Over the last year a few concerned residents of the town of Clover have asked me about the history of the Campground. I was curious myself because I had heard that the property on which the Campground is located was given to the Town and was to be designated to be used as a town park. So a couple week ago I spent some time at the Registrar of Deeds at Washburn to research the Town properties located along Bark Point road from Old School Road to the existing Playground East to West.

① The property where the Campground is located was purchased by the Town from Bayfield County in 1942. for \$638.74. There are no stipulations or reservations on the Deed as to its use.

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② The property which is located between Park Ave and Lake Street which ~~is~~ comprises the pond was deeded to the Town of Clover in the original Bartlett survey addition of 1917 and is shown as Cornell Park on the plot map.

③ The playground as existing is located on 5 (five) lots shown on the Bartlett survey map. Lots (2) (3) & (4) were donated to the Town as far as I can tell on the Deeds; by John's Hovea Erickson in 1979. These 3 lots do have a noted stipulation that they are not to be sold, leased or mortgaged and that any use must meet D.N.R. Regulations. Lot (5) was transferred from Bayfield County to the Town of Clover by Deed Jan 2 1997

③ In March of 1978 the Town of Clover joined the Bayfield Planning and zoning organization and has for as I can tell the above properties were classified as RR1 and are at this time.

Overall I found no intentions or reservations on record for the future use of all properties I researched.
